What Malcolm X said when he got silenced by Elijah Mohammed was in fact true: America's chickens... are coming home to roost. We took this country by terror, away from the Sioux, the Apache, the Arowak, the Comanche, the Arapahoe, the Navajo. Terrorism.

We took Africans from their country to build our way of ease an d kept them enslaved and living in fear. Terrorism.
